Are You Ready To Apply for DOJ Funding?

Submitting an application for funding from the Department of Justice (DOJ) is a two-part process. An entity first submits an abbreviated application in Grants.gov. The full application is then completed in JustGrants, DOJ's grants management system. The <u>DOJ Application Submission</u> <u>Checklist</u> provides step-by-step instructions to help applicants complete DOJ grant applications.

The checklist describes how to ---

- confirm entity registration information in SAM.gov and Grants.gov;
- submit the required application forms in Grants.gov;
- onboard as a new or existing entity in JustGrants;
- complete an application in JustGrants; and
- review, certify, and submit an application.

Your entity will need to identify points of contact for key roles during the application process. Learn about required roles and each person's responsibilities on the JustGrants Resources Entity Management Training page.
