Accepting a DOJ Funding Award

You are receiving this email because your entity has a DOJ award that has not yet been accepted. Once notified of an award by the Department of Justice (DOJ), entity users must complete a twostep process to accept or decline the award:

- 1. **Entity Administrator** confirms or assigns participants to the award, including the Authorized Representative(s).
- 2. Assigned Authorized Representative(s) accepts or declines the award.

When DOJ grants an award, the award becomes available in your entity's profile in JustGrants and must be accepted within 45 days of the award date.

Award recipients are also encouraged to attend one of the Q&A sessions specifically structured for Entity Administrators and Authorized Representatives.
