Where To Find DOJ Funding Opportunities

As Department of Justice (DOJ) funding opportunities become available, you'll find them posted on each agency's website:

- Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS Office) Grants
- Office of Justice Programs (OJP) Current Funding Opportunities
- Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) Open Notices of Funding Opportunities

You can also find open federal funding opportunities on <u>Grants.gov</u> and sign up to receive notifications when new funding is available. DOJ generally announces funding opportunities 45-60 days before the submission deadline. (TIP: Click "All Department of Justice" in the "Agency" box to find all DOJ opportunities.)

You must have active registrations in <u>SAM.gov</u> and <u>Grants.gov</u> *before* you can apply for DOJ funding. If you've used these systems in the past, you still need to ensure your registration and users are current.
