Temporary Suspension of ASAP Accounts for Fiscal Year-End Account Reconciliation

All Department of Justice (DOJ)-related Automated Standard Application for Payments (ASAP) accounts will be temporarily suspended during the last five business days of September 2026. This pause allows the Department to complete fiscal year-end financial reconciliation.

Last Day To Request a Drawdown

The last day DOJ award recipients can request a drawdown in ASAP is **Wednesday, September 23, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. ET.**

What Happens During the Suspension

If recipients try to request a drawdown during the suspension period, ASAP will show an **"Error 839: No accounts found matching criteria"** message. No drawdowns can be requested during this time.

When Drawdowns Resume

Recipients with an open account can resume drawdown requests on **Thursday, October 1, 2026.**
