

# Resolving Validation Errors for Web-Based Budgets



If an applicant receives an error message about the **Federal Estimated Funding**, **Applicant Estimated Funding**, and **Total Estimated Funding** in the **Budget/Financial Attachment** screen, they cannot fix the issue in the **Budget/Financial Attachment** screen. Use the right-hand navigation to return to the **Consolidated Category Summary** screen to fix the issue.

# Resolving Validation Errors for Web-Based Budgets

1. To resolve the error, select the **Consolidated Category Summary** Screen link from the right-hand navigation.
2. Select the red triangle in **Budget Totals**.
3. A popup box appears - select **Yes**. Selecting **Yes** updates the SF-424 information in the **Standard Applicant Information** Screen.
4. Select the **Continue** button again, and the user should be able to move through the application.

**NOTE:** If a user cannot move past the **Budget/Financial Attachment** screen, navigate to a different section of the application via the right-hand navigation. Complete the rest of the application using the right-hand navigation rather than using the Continue button.
